

COMANCO COMPLETES POND LINER FOR LOCAL PRODUCE GROWER

A recent project successfully replaced the geosynthetic liner for a critical pond used by a valued member of our local agricultural community. This project involved replacing the liner for a critical pond in produce cultivation. The project scope included installing 19,849 SF of a 45mil reinforced polypropylene (PP) liner. Led by Superintendent Juan Morales and Foreman Ramon Irrizary, the COMANCO team delivered a meticulous project that resulted in several key improvements:

- Improved Stability: By removing unnecessary metal structures, the teamoptimized liner placement, which reduces the risk of movement andenhances overall stability over time.
- Reinforced Foundation: Washed-out areas were meticulously addressed. Subgrade repairs were conducted, and a new anchor trench was excavated and backfilled.



This comprehensive approach strengthens the foundation, minimizing the impact of erosion and other environmental factors.

The success of this project demonstrates COMANCO's dedication to providing high-quality geosynthetic liner solutions for clients in diverse industries.

COMANCO CREW COMPLETES GOLD MINE LINER IN NEVEDA

COMANCO's skilled crew, led by Superintendent Pablo Medina, recently achieved a successful liner installation for a gold mine project in northern Nevada. The crew navigated various weather conditions during the installation, from sunny days to snowfall.





Despite these variations, they meticulously completed the following:

- Installed a 10oz geotextile layer.
- Installed a primary 80mil HDPE liner.
- Integrated a strategic placement of pipe boots and stainless-steel batten bars.

The project was completed with a flawless safety record, adhering to all MSHA (Mine Safety and Health Administration) regulations. This accomplishment reflects COMANCO's unwavering commitment to safety and quality in every project we undertake.

COMANCO COMPLETES TAMPA POWER PLANT REMEDIATION PROJECT

COMANCO is proud to announce the successful completion of a crucial remediation project for a power plant in Tampa. The COMANCO team mobilized to the site in late 2023, and over 3,800 CY of engineered fill, structural fill, and hardpan were delivered and strategically placed to create a stable foundation for the project. Demucking the existing pond was a critical step, allowing for a stable work surface for the subsequent liner installation and grading. A key element of this project was the innovative utilization of crane pads on the soft soil surrounding the pond. These specialized pads served a dual purpose:

- Using crane pads proved to be a successful solution, prioritizing safety for the crew and minimizing environmental impact. By proactively addressing potential risks, COMANCO ensured a smooth project completion.
- Safety: They created a firm and level foundation for heavy machinery, preventing accidents and injuries for the crew.
- Environmental Protection: Crane pads reduce the risk of erosion and contamination, especially in sensitive areas, by minimizing soil disturbance.



COMANCO EXPEDITES CONSTRUCTION ON NEW LANDFILL CELL

To have the cell ready as soon as possible, COMANCO has moved more than 150,000 CY of dirt, preparing 10 acres of subgrade for a liner in record time. While doing the earthwork, COMANCO coordinated with our partners Agru and Skaps the material production and testing to have all geosynthetics delivered on time for installation. The future cell has already been blacked out with more than 425,000 SF of geomembrane and over 15,000 SF of GCL.



COMANCO is now working on geocomposite installation and waiting for the last batch of material to be delivered to complete the task. Right behind the geocomposite installation is the protective cover placement, where COMANCO has already moved more than 25,000 CY of sandy material and placed it on top of the geocomposite. This 2 FT material will protect the geosynthetic layers below from the waste stacked on top of them shortly.



Together with the protective cover, COMANCO has its drain crew working on the leachate collection system that lays in the middle of the cell from north to south. Everything looks good to have this cell done with high quality quickly.

With the foundation laid and critical layers installed, COMANCO is on track for a speedy completion of this new cell. Our commitment to collaboration and efficiency ensures this project will be ready to receive waste ahead of schedule.

COMANCO ADVANCES WITH NEW CLASS I LANDFILL CELL IN FLORIDA

COMANCO is excited to announce progress on constructing a new Class I Landfill Cell in Central Florida. Through close collaboration with our client, the COMANCO team has achieved significant milestones:

- Installed 642,280 SF of Geosynthetic Clay Liner
- Installed 1,282,200 SF of Geocomposite
- Installed 1,291,430 SF of Liner

These impressive accomplishments mark the near completion of the five-layer system within the cell footprint. A second mobilization is planned for the coming weeks. This phase will focus on:

- Installing a run tarp over the protective cover sand.
- Installing a rain flap around designated areas of the cell perimeter. COMANCO will utilize highquality materials from trusted suppliers to deliver a durable and environmentally responsible solution. The crew's successful completion of the last two cells at this location demonstrates their expertise and dedication.
